CRCHC AWARDED \$3 MILLION FROM AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN

Concord, NC- Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Centers, Inc. (CRCHC) will receive \$3 million out of nearly \$150 million from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 set out to support community-based healthcare providers. These investments from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) are intended to strengthen COVID-19 response efforts, increase vaccine distribution, and improve health care services in communities across the country. This funding was made possible by The Health Resources and Services Administrations (HRSA), as part of the HHS, and the Biden Administration's commitment to help communities hit hardest by the pandemic.

CRCHC plans to increase COVID-19 testing and vaccine distribution across Cabarrus County and Rowan County. COVID testing is offered multiple times a week, spread out at varying locations in order to reach as many people as possible. Testing is offered to anyone who thinks they have COVID, needs a test for work, school, or travel. CRCHC is offering the choice of either the Moderna vaccine or the Johnson & Johnson Janssen vaccine to any eligible adult eighteen years of age or older. Vaccines are offered at multiple locations and varying times during the week in order to reach as many patients as possible who would like a COVID vaccine.
