

CRCHC Opening New Clinic in Charlotte, NC

Concord, NC – Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Centers is proud to announce that the organization will be opening a new clinic in Mecklenburg County.

Sugar Creek Health Center will be opening in early 2024 in the Charlotte Area. The new clinic will offer a wide range of medical services to the local community, including women's health, pediatrics, chronic disease management, behavioral health services, and dental care. The health center will be staffed by a team of highly trained medical professionals who provide top-quality care to patients of all ages. Sugar Creek Health Center will prioritize accessibility and affordability. It will offer a sliding fee scale for uninsured patients. The sliding fee scale allows the organization to discount a patient's services based on their income and family size. Families that qualify for a discount under the sliding scale will be asked to pay a nominal fee. CRCHC's mobile unit began holding remote clinics onsite on November 8th until the physical opening of the new clinic.

"We are beyond excited to announce the opening of our ninth location in Charlotte, NC soon that will bring medical, dental, behavioral health, imaging, and other ancillary services to Mecklenburg County. We are truly thankful for the support and partnership from the Mecklenburg County Commissioners to expand access to healthcare for the residents in Mecklenburg County," said CEO Don Holloman.
