"COVID-19 was a huge challenge in our field. Telehealth has been introduced. I think providing Telehealth appointments due to COVID had a big impact which brings advantages and disadvantages to the community we serve." Karen said. She is here to understand patients' struggles in a non-judgmental manner, accept differences, and help individuals develop goals they want to accomplish themselves. Karen learns many things from her patients, but one major thing is that they are experts in their own lives; she's there to help them discover their potential.

Beyond Behavioral Health, Karen is family oriented and enjoys family activities, catching up on shows, and maintaining an active lifestyle.
